On June 13, 2006, distinguished leaders from around the world, along with thousands of Ambassadors for Peace from 192 nations, and millions of Korean citizens, will celebrate a crowning moment in the life and work of Rev. Dr. Sun Myung Moon, now in his 87th year. 
